



Congratulations to each of you on having completed your studies and all you have accomplished at Bishop Byrne High School!



Wherever your future takes you, and whatever your dreams call you to do, I pray that you will do so with faith, hope and love that reflects the goodness of our Almighty God.




Scholarship, Leadership, Service, Character and Knowledge.

National Honor Society members are chosen on the basis of scholarship, leadership, service, and character. The selection process starts with scholarship. Those sophomores, juniors, and seniors who have a cumulative grade point average of 3.25 or better are placed on the list. These students must have the equivalent for four academic courses each year — courses such as: Biology and Algebra. Then the faculty judges each student on the other three qualities: leadership, character and service. A faculty committee makes the final choices based on the assessments and comments made by all of the faculty.
